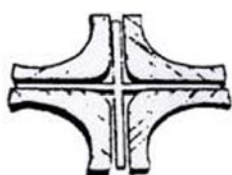

Catching the Wave of God's Dream

On Sunday, November 22, members of our congregation met for an initial meeting of "Catching the Wave of God's Dream." For two years, the staff and leaders of our congregation have been considering where God is leading our congregation. On November 22, we enlarged the discussion to include all members of our congregation. It was a fun evening. The food was great. The energy was strong. The Spirit's presence seemed very real. As one person said, "This looks like a wave to me!" For several years, Gloria Dei has been in transition. For many, November 22 marked the end of this time of transition. We are now gearing up for a new and exciting ministry.



What this new ministry might be we don't yet know. Two things seem clearer after our past two years of praying and talking. First, we need to catch God's wave. Churches make a mistake when they make plans and then ask God to bless what they have decided to do. Who knows if it is really a good idea? Instead of this process, we want to figure out what God is doing and then join him. As in surfing, the surfer "catches a wave" that takes him to the shore. So, too, we want to catch God's wave – join God in what he is doing in our midst.

Annual Meeting

Book Club

The idea for a book club began in January 2000 when Pastor Ronningen led a two-week discussion of **TUESDAYS WITH MORRIE**, by Mitch Albom. Ten years and 89 books later, we begin another year. In addition to the friendship of the members, you are introduced to new authors and books you may not have thought you would like. One of our greatest discussions was on a book, very few liked or finished reading, but we sure had a great afternoon trying to figure out where the author was going!



We will begin the 2010 year on Tuesday, January 12, at 2:00 in the Fireside Room. The book selected is, **HIDING in the SPOTLIGHT**, by Greg Dawson. This is the story of a musical prodigy's survival during 1941-1946.

By the age of six, a spunky little girl named Zhanna, the daughter of a candy-maker from a tiny seaside village in the Ukraine, has already developed the repertoire of a student twice her age. She had given her first public performance and was being offered scholarships to the most prestigious conservatories in the Soviet Union. But in 1941, disaster strikes, when the German army is smashing through the Ukraine en route to Moscow. Zhanna and her family are to be executed alongside thousands of other Jews. A few short miles from certain death, she escapes into the forest with only the clothes on her back and a copy of Chopin's *Fantasy Impromptu* in her pocket, her father's words echoing in her ears, "I don't care what you do, just live!"

Adopting a new identity and ever fearful of recognition, Zhanna roams the ravaged countryside. One lonely evening a local piano tuner hears her play and brings her to a Nazi commander, who is so taken with her exquisite talent that she soon becomes the performing darling of the Nazi forces, entertaining soldiers and officers with renditions of Chopin, Brahms, and Schubert, all to the cry

of *Noch einmal*." The cruel irony of her situation was never lost on the young girl, and yet her father's parting admonition to survive carried her through, culminating in a very different performance in 1946, when she performed for the survivors of Dachau and the American soldiers who had liberated them. A nocturne on the strength of human spirit, Zhanna's story is powerful, haunting, and unforgettable.

For February 9, we have selected **THE KABUL BEAUTY SCHOOL**, by Deborah Rodriguez. This is a true story, which alternates between hilarious and moving. More next month on this book and other selections for March, April and May.

Everyone is welcome to come and join us (you do not need a special invitation) on the second Tuesday of the month at 2:00 p.m. (September – May) in the Fireside Room, as we discuss books and enjoy fellowship with one another. 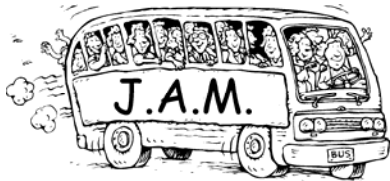

The meeting will be less of a business meeting and more of a celebration. We will take a vote on the budget and have the election of officers and board members. Reports will be given in a multi-media review rather than in booklet form as in the past (Members will still receive a copy of the budget, a list of candidates for election, and statistics from the year). The Sunday prior to the annual meeting, a forum will be held at 9:15 and 10:45 for members to ask questions about the budget or other matters of business (see article below). We hope that this will make it possible to have a very short business part of our day.

Why the change? For those who have attended our annual meeting the last two years, we have already moved in this direction. We have had very little discussion about business matters of the church. Very large churches like Gloria Dei are extremely complicated. No longer can we run the organization through a town-hall style meeting where the minutia of the organization can be analyzed by all present. Likewise, fewer and fewer members are interested in devoting time to try to manage the organization in this way. Very large churches, like Gloria Dei, are moving away from the traditional business meeting to a time of celebration. So we shall handle briefly what business we have, then move on to celebrate what God has been doing the past year with a multi-media presentation, followed by a presentation of where we are going in 2010. This presentation will continue the discussion of "Catching the Wave of God's Dream." We will have some definite plans for the future ministry of Gloria Dei.

We trust that the changes noted will not be too disruptive and that in the end will help us move along in our plans for ministry. Join us at noon, on Sunday, January 24.
